1. Applicants may receive grants in any, or all years, that they meet the criteria of residence.
2. Applicants must live in the parish of North Petherton, which includes North Newton, Moorland, Fordgate, Huntworth, Woolmersdon, Stockmoor, Wilstock and Somerset Bridge.
3. Grants may be awarded to cover specified book or software costs, specific equipment or tools, expedition travel and specialised clothing/uniform.
4. Exact prices must be quoted for individual items when applying. For example:  
*New A-level Maths for Edexcel, from Amazon £9.97*  
*Littmann Stethoscope, from Amazon £71.99*  
*Chefs' easy fit trousers, from Workwear Express £20.75*
5. Grants are **not** given for daily travel, bus passes, daily living costs or accommodation.
6. All applications must be completed and signed by the applicant, not parent or carer.
7. All applications for under 18's must be countersigned by a parent or carer.
8. All applications must be countersigned by the course tutor.
9. All Applications will be considered in early November. Please note that applicants awarded from the Cheeke and Stodgell fund may take longer to process.
10. All successful applicants are expected to write a letter of acknowledgement and thanks to the trustees.
