North Petherton Playing Fields Charitable Trust (NPPFCT) manages the North Petherton Memorial Park which came into being in 1955 to be maintained as a recreation ground and playing field for the inhabitants of North Petherton.

Along side the Memorial Park but outside its boundary adjacent to the A38 there is a memorial stone with an inscription

NPPFCT have taken the decision to re locate the Memorial Stone to somewhere that is safer for people to gather and pay their respects.
